Visitors are requested to register between 10 - 10.25am, ready for the Welcome Address at 10.30am in our Concert Hall.

We're located on the corner of Oxford Road and Booth Street West, one mile south of the city centre. Manchester is an ever evolving city which can mean diversions, so we recommend visitors travel by public transport where possible. Oxford Road connects the RNCM by bus to the city centre and to Oxford Road, Piccadilly and Victoria railway stations. Oxford Road Station is approximately a 15 minute walk away and our main entrance is on Booth Street West.

By Taxi

Taxi ranks are at each railway station and the fare to the RNCM is approximately £8 - 9. If you're travelling from Manchester Airport, the fare is approximately £25 - £30.
