International undergraduates and UK and International full-time postgraduate students

1. The College may consider providing limited financial assistance, in the form of bursaries. It should be noted, however, that the College's bursary funds are limited.
2. Preference will be given to applicants who can provide evidence that they have secured financial support from sources other than College funds.
3. Applicants for bursaries are required to complete the attached application form, and to provide written statements from parents, spouse/partner, other sponsors and donors. Applications will be scrutinised by members of the Student Awards Committee.
4. All possible sources of finance – i.e. competitions, sponsorship, trusts, and grant awarding bodies – should be explored well before the commencement of studentships.
5. It is the responsibility of the student to ensure that they have sufficient funding for the payment of fees and living costs.
6. Students will normally only be permitted to register on the programme following full payment of fees.
