The College welcomes applications from disabled students. The College's policy is that access should be within the reach of any candidate who is able to demonstrate at audition a high level of performing achievement and potential. Factors such as disability, race, country of origin, gender, sexual orientation, marital status, religious beliefs, political beliefs, or social class play no part in our assessment of a candidate's suitability for training. Under no circumstances would the College tolerate discrimination against any student during her or his studentship or beyond on any of these grounds.

The College is committed to making reasonable adjustments to its day-to-day practices and premises if it is found that these place individuals who have a disability at a disadvantage.

The College works closely with other conservatoires in the sharing of best practice and developments in relation to supporting disabled students and devising alternative means of assessment.
